

**Colourful Clematis**

An appliqué and embroidery workshop with Jennifer Hughes – Saturday 17<sup>th</sup> July



The aim of the workshop was to produce a decorative picture of clematis using the techniques of appliqué and embroidery on a hand painted background.

Jennifer produced a range of beautiful and artistic examples for us to aspire to. She also brought pictures of clematis for inspiration.

Firstly we painted a background using acrylic paints on pieces of unbleached cotton. Jennifer provided a range of tasteful, pre cut petals and leaves to make the flowers and leaves which we stitched on using a running stitch. Most people stitched on one flower, intending to add others later. Jennifer also showed us how to make fluffy centres for the flowers, seed heads, silk ribbon daisies and needle lace leaves.


I found it quite difficult to paint the background so that it looked nice and position the items artistically so that they produced an attractive composition. In the end I favoured the random approach to the background and flowers, but was defeated by the positioning of the leaves. In answer to my distress call, Jennifer came and positioned them for me, explaining how they grow and I pinned them and stitched them exactly where she put them. Interestingly we stitched on the petals and leaves without finishing their edges and they didn't seem to fray. If you don't normally embroider it was an interesting change and everyone was very engrossed in their activity.

I'm not sure what I will do with my creation, it would probably be designated a "solid effort" rather than "lovely" and I went away from the class with the thought that the class was an example of how a flair for artistic design can raise a picture above the ordinary.

They brought some attractive Japanese papers for us to play with, and ready cut sheets for the pages. The pages were stitched into the covers using several types of pattern, so each of the books looks a little different. Those of us who had time, then made a coloured card slip box, and we left with a most impressive little set of handmade books in its own box.

I was quite tickled pink with mine. Even my husband admired it – a sure sign of success!
